Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

If you are interested in serving the parish as a Lector or Extraordinary Minister of Holy Communion, a required Diocesan Training Session will be held at 7:00pm on Tuesday, August 22 at St. Paul Church in Florence. **Please follow these steps.**

**First, call our parish office 441-1604** to have your name, phone number and email address placed on the form to be submitted to the Diocesan Worship Office **before August 7<sup>th</sup>** (sorry for the short notice). You will also be given the password to register online.

**Second, register online for the Diocesan Training Session.** If you do not already have the password, contact one of the parish priests, deacon, Mr. John McNabb (Lectors) 442-0005 or Mrs. Jeanne Pettit (EMHC) 441-8371. Or you can ask the parish secretary to register you.

**Finally, a short in-parish training session** will be scheduled for you, once you have completed the Diocesan training.

We are always especially glad to have younger parishioners serve as Lectors and EMHC. Minimum age is 16 years old, the person must be confirmed and actively practice the Catholic faith. Lectors and EMHC are able to set the days and Mass times for their ministry.

These are invaluable ministries for the parish. Lectors help proclaim and even interpret the Word of God by their ministry. EMHC mention how moved and humbled they are when they distribute the Body and Blood of Christ. Some EMHC also take Holy Communion to the sick and confined of the parish. This ministry is especially appreciated by our homebound parishioners.

Please give some prayerful thought to serving St. Joseph Parish in one of these ministries.

**Qualifications for those who wish to serve as a Lector or Extraordinary Minister of Holy Communion are:**

- 1) fully initiated Catholics (Baptism, Confirmation, Eucharist)
- 2) at least 16 years old
- 3) evidence their love for the Eucharist by regular participation in Sunday Mass
- 4) demonstrate that the Catholic faith forms their way of life
- 5) not be under a Canonical imposition (E.g. an invalid marriage)
- 6) recommended by their pastor/parochial vicar for a four-year term renewable
- 7) willing to commit to serving at scheduled Masses

**SCRIPTURE REFLECTION**

After all was said and done, it appears that Peter understood the meaning of the Lord's transfiguration. In the second reading, the writer of 2 Peter offers the fruit of Peter's reflections. In contrast to the crackling splendor of that visionary experience, he offers the image of quiet lamplight, the steady flame tended by those who are awake and whose hope burns through the night "until day dawns and the morning star rises in your hearts" (2 Peter 1:19).

The reality of the life-giving Lord is inside us; we can take it along. It sustains us when we turn to the work of every day. We cannot sustain peak experiences, but we can tend the steady lamps that light our way and soften the night. The morning star flickers in our inner selves. The triumphant, risen Christ is named the morning star in the Easter *Exsultet* that rings out in the night and ushers in the celebration of the Resurrection. Jesus' transfiguration told us this would be so.
