### **Parish Council:**

The Saint Joseph Parish Council is an advisory council made up of parish staff members, representatives of other parish organizations and at least 9 lay members elected by parishioners. It is a consultative body regarding pastoral and administrative needs of the parish. It also serves to strengthen communications between various organizations and constituencies of the parish.

Parish Council meetings are usually at 7:30pm on the fourth Tuesday of each month.

### **Requirements for Parish Council:**

1. A registered, practicing, confirmed Catholic and member of St. Joseph Parish who is 18 years of age or older.
2. Participates in parish communal worship, especially Sunday Mass and the reception of the Sacraments.
3. Able to commit to attending monthly meetings of the Parish Council.
4. Commit to serve a three year term and serve on a Parish Council committee (Liturgy & Worship, Finance, Planning/Development/Maintenance, Social Action & Outreach, Public Relations & Communications, Stewardship, Youth & Family Life).

### **Board of Education:**

The St. Joseph Board of Education is an advisory board made up of 9 elected members. Its focus is promoting, recommending and evaluating parish related education programs, particularly religious education programs, for all members of the parish including St. Joseph School and Parish School of Religion.

Board of Education meetings are usually at 7:30pm on the second Wednesday of each month.

### **Requirements for Board of Education:**

1. A registered, practicing, confirmed Catholic and member of St. Joseph Parish who is 18 years of age or older.
2. Participates in parish communal worship, especially Sunday Mass and the reception of the Sacraments.
3. Able to commit to attending monthly BOE meetings and other supportive activities.
4. Commit to serve a three year term and serve on a BOE committee (Adult Faith Formation, Marketing & Communication, Finance, Pre-School, Special Events).
