GOING TO CHURCH AND THE FLU

There is a general concern in the community about the flu, especially the H1N1 flu strain. This prompts specific concerns about attending Mass and avoiding the spread of the flu.

Normal precautions should be taken.

- 1) Maintain a healthy life-style.
- 2) Wash your hands frequently and/or use an alcohol based hand sanitizer, especially after coughing.
- 3) Avoid touching your nose, mouth and eyes.
- 4) Cover your coughs and sneezes with a tissue or cough into your elbow.
- 5) Keep frequently touched common surfaces clean.
- 6) Stay home while symptoms are present and for 24 hours after you are symptom-free
Symptoms include fever, chills *and* coughing or sore throat, runny nose, body aches, headache, tiredness, diarrhea or vomiting.
- 7) Get vaccinated against seasonal flu.

Specific efforts to avoid spreading the flu at St. Joe's include:

- 1) **Stay home from Mass if you are feeling sick or have flu symptoms.** No sin is incurred in this case. We are not expected to jeopardize our health or the health of others in order to fulfill our Sunday obligation.
- 2) **Just before Mass Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion, deacons and priests are to use the hand sanitizer** placed near the sign-in book.
- 3) **We will continue the sign of peace as usual. If you prefer, feel free not to extend your hand.** Another sign may be given, such as a nod of the head and simply saying, "The peace of Christ be with you".
- 4) **Do not receive communion from the cup if you have any symptoms of the flu or cold.**
