GOING TO CHURCH AND THE FLU

There is a general concern in the community about the flu, especially the H1N1 flu strain. This prompts specific concerns about attending Mass and avoiding the spread of the flu. **Specific efforts to avoid spreading the flu at St. Joe's include:**

- 1) **Stay home from Mass if you are feeling sick or have flu symptoms.** No sin is incurred in this case. We are not expected to jeopardize our health or the health of others in order to fulfill our Sunday obligation.
- 2) **Just before Mass Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion, deacons and priests are to use the hand sanitizer placed near the sign-in book.**
- 3) **We will continue the sign of peace as usual. If you prefer, feel free not to extend your hand.** Another sign may be given, such as a nod of the head and simply saying, "The peace of Christ be with you".
- 4) **Do not receive communion from the cup if you have any symptoms of the flu or cold.**
