PENTECOST SUNDAY

Reflection...And this Spirit is a Spirit of forgiveness. We learn this in today's Gospel. We are brought back in time from Pentecost and the early Church (about eighty years out) to the first Easter evening. In this most quiet dusk, Jesus comes to his chastened, confused, and frightened apostles, who do not know which way to turn. He offers them a greeting of peace, and then gives them a mission. This has to have been a surprise. Why give this bunch a mission, a work of continuing his own work on earth?

How on earth are they to carry on? By, through, with, and in the gift of the Holy Spirit. Jesus passes on the very breath of his life, the Holy Spirit. This gift, this indwelling Holy Spirit, is to manifest itself in the most difficult of human gestures—forgiveness. A fallible assembly, such as this one in this room on this evening, is as good an image of humankind as any. It needs a Holy Spirit of forgiveness. And it needs it badly.

NATIONALLY RANKED BBHS STUDENTS:

CHARLES DeMOSS and GABRIELL SEE, Juniors of Bishop Brossart High School ranked nationally in the 75th annual event, according to Lisa Narug, National Director of *Le Grand Concours*.

The American Association of Teachers of French sponsors this competition. The purpose of the *National French Contest* is to help stimulate further interest in the teaching and learning of French and to help identify and reward achievement on the part of both students and teachers.

Students are evaluated for their written, listening and reading skills in French. Over 100,100 students in 50 states competed in the 2010 event. CHARLES DeMOSS, a junior in his 3rd year of French, placed 9th in the nation. CHARLES is the son of Catherine Rust of Camp Springs and Chris DeMoss of Alexandria.
